(Items in yellow are new as of 4/4/2022)

**Unvaccinated Children**

**Domestic guidelines:**

● **Travel by Car:** Testing is not required if traveling by car. While we are not requiring testing for domestic travel by car, we encourage families to assess their level of risk and get a COVID test as appropriate based on their activities (water parks, amusement parks) and their state destination.

● **Air Travel:** If you travel by air, a child needs to take a **PCR test** the day after they come back. (Rapid PCR's acceptable-appointments can be made in advance). Return with a negative test.

- For example if you travel to a high risk area or fly and return on a Sunday, your child needs to test on Monday and if you do acquire a **rapid PCR** they may return that same day.

**International guidelines:**

- **All International Travel (both vaccinated and unvaccinated) a child needs to quarantine for a full 5 days.** Quarantine begins the day after they return. A PCR (Rapid PCRs acceptable-appointments can be made in advance) needs to be taken during days 3-5. Return with a negative result.

**Vaccinated Children or Children that have had COVID-19 in the past days**

- **If your child is vaccinated or has had COVID-19 in the past 90 days and you travel within the 50 United States (not including Puerto Rico) they do not need to test.**
